NOTIFICATION

1. Rules for open competitive examination to be conducted by the Sikkim Public Service Commission in 2018 for selection of candidates for appointment to the post of Sub-Inspector are published for general information.

2. The Examination being for recruitment to the post of Sub-Inspector under Excise (Abk) Department, Government of

Sikkim.

3. The number of vacancies to the filled on the results of the examination will be specified in the Notice issued by the Sikkim Public Service Commission.

4. The examination including Physical Efficiency cum Physical Endurance Test will be conducted by the Sikkim Public Service Commission according to standards, marks and syllabus, as provided in the Appendix I, II to these rules.

5. Candidates in Central or State Government Service or in Central or State Government owned undertaking or other organizations, whether in permanent or temporary capacity or as work charged shall be required to submit their applications along with the No Objection Certificate of their employer.

6. The Sikkim Public Service Commission will hold a Physical Endurance Test prior to the conduct of main written examination. If the candidate disqualified/failed in one event

his candidature will be treated as disqualified.

7. The date and place of examination will be fixed by the Sikkim Public Service Commission.

8. Candidates must write answers in their own handwriting. In no circumstances will they be allowed to take the help of a scribe to write the answers for them.

9. The Commission shall have discretion to fix qualifying marks

in any or all subjects to the written examinations.

successful candidates qualifying in Physical 10. Efficiency cum Physical Endurance Test will only be allowed to sit in the main examination.

The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or 11. other wise of a candidate for admission to the examination

shall be final.

No candidate will be admitted to the examination unless he holds a certificate admission issued by the Commission. Their admission to all the stages of the Examination will be purely PROVISIONAL subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility condition. Mere issue of admission certificate to the candidate will not imply that his candidatures have been finally cleared by the Commission.

13. A candidate must pay fee as may be prescribed by the

Commission.

14. A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission to be guilty or any attempt on this part to obtain support for his candidature by any means shall render himself to be disqualified for admission to the competitive examination.

15. After the PET, Main examination and Viva Voce, the names of the successful candidates will be arranged by the Commission in the order of merit based on aggregate marks finally awarded to each candidate. Candidates shall be recommended by the Commission for appointment to the available vacancies in the order in which their names appear in the merit list of different categories.

16. The form and manner of announcement of results of the examination shall be decided at the discretion of Commission. The Commission will not entertain in any

correspondence with any candidate regarding results.

17. A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission guilty of impersonation or of submitting false and fabricated documents which have been tempered with or making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information or of using or of attempting to use unfair means in the examination hall or otherwise resorting to any other irregular or improper means for obtaining admission to the examination may, in addition to rendering himself liable to be prosecuted, or be debarred:-

(a) By the Commission permanently or for specified period for admission to any examination or appearance at any of the Viva Voce held by the Commission for selection of

candidates.

(b) By the State Government from any employment under them.

- Success in examination confers no right to appointment unless Government is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that a candidate having regard to his character and antecedents is suitable in all respects for appointment.
- A candidate must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the discharge of his duties as an officer of the Excise (Abk) Department. A candidate who (after such medical examination as may be prescribed by the competent authority) is found not to satisfy these requirements will not be appointed.

20 If a candidate's handwriting is not easily legible, a deduction may be made in this accounts from the total marks otherwise

accruing to him.

- 21 Credit will be given to orderly, effective and exact expression combined with economy of words in all subjects of the examination.
- No travelling duty allowance will be paid for the journey performed in connection with the examination, physical endurance-cum-physical efficiency test, Viva Voce and medical examination.
- All other matters not specified or for which no provision has been made in these rules shall be regulated by rules and orders applicable to the Service to which recruitment is being made.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

The competitive examination comprises of 3 successive stages.

1st Stage: Physical Endurance-cum-Physical Efficiency Test (PET)- 100 Marks.

- 1. All the applicants have to appear in the Physical Endurance-cum-Physical Efficiency Test (PET).
- 2. Candidates appearing in the PET should qualify in each of the following five events. Failure to qualify in any one of the events would mean their disqualification for the post of Sub-Inspector.
- 3. The candidates those qualified in PET, the Sikkim Public Service Commission shall draw a merit list to call for appearing in the main examination.

The standards of Physical Endurance-cum-Physical Efficiency Test prescribed for Sub-Inspector are as follows:-

(a) 100 Meter Race:-

The time taken from start to finish is noted by means of a stopwatch and recorded. Candidates will have only one chance at the event.





(c) Shot-Put (three chances)

A circle 7.11 meters in diameter will be drawn. Two lines 30 and 60 will be drawn to form the sector in which the shot is to be thrown. Three arcs will then be drawn in this sector all distances stated above from the front edge of the circle. Each candidate will have three chances with 16 lb weight for men and 12 lb weight for women and his/her best performance level A, B or C will be recorded and marks awarded accordingly. If while throwing, a candidate touches the ground in front of circle it will be treated as a foul. Whether fair or foul only three chances will be allowed.

(d) High Jump (Maximum three chances at the qualifying level and one chance of each subsequent level)

The cross bar is placed at the minimum height. Those who qualify in three or less attempts will be allowed one attempt at the next level. Those who qualify this level will be allowed one attempt at the last level. Candidates are placed in the level A,B or C as per their best hump and given marks accordingly.

(e) Long Jump (Maximum three chances)

Three lines are marked at three distances indicated prepage from the front edge of the take off point. Each candidate will have three jumps and will be placed in level A,B or C as per his best jump and marks will be awarded accordingly. If while jumping a candidate touches the ground beyond the edge of the take off point it will be treated as a foul. Whether fair or foul, only three jumps will be allowed.
