NOTIFICATION

Rules for open competitive examination to be conducted by the Sikkim Public Service Commission in 2023 for selection of candidates for appointment to the post of Laboratory Assistant are published for general information.

- 1.** The examination being for recruitment to the post of Laboratory Assistant under Excise Department, Government of Sikkim.
- 2.** The number of vacancies to be filled on the results of the examination will be specified in the Notice issued by the Sikkim Public Service Commission. Candidates must submit the application through online website.
- 3.** The examination will be conducted by the Sikkim Public Service Commission according to standards, Marks and syllabus, as provided in the Appendix I to these rules.
- 4.** Candidates in Central or State Government Service or in Central or state Government owned undertaking or other organization, whether in permanent or temporary capacity or as work charged shall be required to submit their applications along with the No Objection Certificate of their employer.
- 5.** The date and place of examination will be fixed by Sikkim Public Service Commission.
- 6.** Candidates must write answers in their own hand. In no circumstance he/she will be allowed the help of a scribe to write the answers for them.
- 7.** The Sikkim Public Service Commission shall have discretion to fix qualifying marks in any or all subjects in the written examinations.
- 8.** The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate for admission to the examination shall be final.
- 9.** No candidate will be admitted to the examination unless he/she holds a Admit Card issued by the Commission. Their admission to all the stages of the examination will be purely PROVISIONAL subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility condition. Mere issue of Admit Card to the candidate will not imply that his candidature has been finally cleared by the Commission.
- 10.** A candidate must pay fee as prescribed by the Commission.
- 11.** A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission to be guilty of any attempt on his part to obtain support for his candidature by any means shall render himself to be disqualified for admission to the competitive examination.
- 12.** After Main examination, the names of the successful candidates will be arranged by the Commission in the order of merit based on aggregate marks finally awarded to each candidate. Candidates shall be recommended by the Commission for appointment to the available vacancies in the order in which their names appear on the merit list of different categories.

13. The form and manner of announcement of results of the examination shall be decided at the discretion of Commission. The Commission will not entertain in any correspondence with any candidate regarding results. Candidate are also informed that the marks, category wise out of marks and answer keys of the Examination, total marks of main examination will not be provided until the entire process of the Examination is over i.e. after the declaration of final result. No application in this regards will entertained.

14. A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission guilty of impersonation or of submitting false and fabricated documents which have been tempered with or making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing materials information or of using or of attempting to use unfair means in the examination hall or otherwise resorting to any other irregular or improper means for obtaining admission to the Examination may, in addition to rendering himself liable to be prosecuted, or be debarred:-

(a) By the Commission permanently or for specified period for admission to any examination held by the Department for selection of candidates.

(b) By the state Government from any employment under them.

15. Success in examination confers no right to appointment unless Government is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that a candidate having regard to his character and antecedents suitable in all respects for appointment.


16. A candidate must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the discharge of his/her duties as an official of the Excise Department. A candidate, who (after such medical examination as may be prescribed by the competent authority) is found not to satisfy these requirements will not be appointed.

17. If a candidate's handwriting is not easily legible, a deduction may be made in this account from the total marks otherwise accruing to him.

18. No travelling duty allowance will be paid for the journey performed in connection with the examination.

19. All other matters not specified or for which no provision has been made in these rules shall be regulated by rules and orders applicable to the Service to which recruitment is being made.
